You will be given the chance to taste cheeses with some wonderful names including GoaShee, Kirkham's Lancashire, Baron Bigod, Hafod Cheddar, Old Winchester, and Young Buck, all of which have been produced at specialist creameries in the UK.



The virtual tasting lasts for one hour. The six 100g portions of cheese to be tasted will be delivered to your address in time for the tasting, along with the matched accompaniments to enjoy at the same time.

A recommendation for a choice of wines to drink on the occasion will be sent to you, courtesy of the Wine Committee Chairman, Philip Parris.
